- Photo Copy ID (Passport or drivers license)

Self-Employed:

- Verified letter of your annual income
- Top 2 pages of most recent 1040 or 1099 tax returns
- Two most recent bank statements
- Reference letter from landlord
- Photo Copy ID (Passport or drivers license)

Student:

- Student ID
- Student Schedule
- Guarantor who makes 80 to 100 times the monthly rent
- Letter of employment on company letter head
- Two most recent bank statements
- Two most recent pay stubs
- Top 2 pages of most recent 1040 tax returns
- Landlord reference letter

Guarantor:

- Letter of employment on a company letter head
- Top 2 pages of most recent 1040 tax returns
- Two most recent bank statements
- Two most recent pay stubs
- If needed, Landlord reference letter
- Photo Copy ID (Passport or drivers license)
